#### THE FORESIGHT SANDBOX: STRATEGIC FORESIGHT EXECUTIVE TRAINING:

Prescient LLC and Arizona State University's School for the Future of Innovation in Society are pleased to offer The Foresight Sandbox, an innovative professional learning experience that combines strategic foresight training with hands-on planning in the era of emerging technology. The pilot program, to be held June 17-19 in Washington DC, will focus on artificial intelligence. Technology is often isolated as a strategic driver of development, change, or risk. This course takes an integrated and holistic approach. Participants will leave the course empowered with foresight skills and frameworks, and with a draft strategy in hand for addressing the challenges and opportunities of AI in their organization.
