UNCERTAINTY AND FORESIGHT GUIDE: As practitioners, we recognize that greater uncertainty means an increased need for foresight as it offers a structured approach to analyze and prepare for uncertainty. While we have seen an increased interest, the list of potential disruptors is fairly daunting—long-term impacts of the pandemic, economic cycles and inflation, climate issues, policy-making, consumer attitudes, societal shifts, supply chain restructuring, and geopolitics. Unfortunately, we have not seen associated changes in planning behavior. This guide may help you communicate to leaders the value of Foresight. (POC: Maria Bothwell)

STRATEGIC FORESIGHT 101: GSA's Center of Excellence (CoE) Innovation Adoption (IA) practice created this resource to help orient you to strategic foresight and design futures methods to better anticipate risk and prepare for the future. IFTF FORESIGHT ESSENTIALS (Nov 21-Dec 15, 2022): Registration is open for UH's 5 day in-person Foresight boot camp. The seminar offers a hands-on approach to foresight, guiding participants through a project using UH's Framework Foresight process, with theory, exercises, and discussions. Participants receive a Professional Certificate in Foresight. Students can obtain a separate Certificate of Achievement by completing a post-program project, which qualifies as one criterion for membership to the Association of Professional Futurists.
